Pass **GACE I** or Exempt w/ 1000+ on SAT (no min on Verbal or Math) or Exempt w/ combined score of 43+ on ACT. If GACE I is needed, take exam in Freshman Year since it has Math.

Pass **GACE II** in Content Area during **Senior Year**.
